This document is tabled for discussion purposes only. It is not necessarily representative of the position any Party may take in treaty negotiations, it contains no admissions and is subject to change. It is without prejudice and will not be tendered or relied upon in any court proceedings.

For the purposes of Agreement-In-Principle negotiations on the topic of Cultural Resources, the Parties agree to negotiate:

1. Common definitions such as Ktunaxa Cultural Resources, Artifacts, Sacred Objects, Ancestral Human Remains, Ktunaxa Sites and others that may be required during the course of negotiations;
2. Ktunaxa law making authority (jurisdiction) for Ktunaxa Cultural Resources in a defined geographic area;
3. The relationship between federal, provincial and Ktunaxa laws;
4. Means to minimize conflicts of laws and to establish priority of laws in the event of conflicts of laws;
5. The extent of the Ktunaxa role in the management of Ktunaxa Cultural Resources held by Canada or British Columbia;
6. A Ktunaxa role in the presentation of Ktunaxa Cultural Resources by Canada or British Columbia in their museums, interpretative centres, exhibition centres or other means; and
7. Which Ktunaxa Cultural Resources, in the possession of Canada or British Columbia, will be returned to the Ktunaxa.

Treaty Linkages

The Agreement-In-Principle will cross reference and link Cultural Resources to other aspects of the Agreement-In-Principle, some of which include:

- Access
- Dispute resolution
- Environmental assessment
- Fish & wildlife
- Forestry
- General Provisions
- Governance
- Implementation
- Lands
- Parks & protected areas
