## WILDLIFE AND MIGRATORY BIRDS

- 1 The Final Agreement will clarify and confirm Ktunaxa rights to Wildlife and Migratory Birds for sustenance, societal and ceremonial purposes.
- 2 The Parties agree that conservation is the paramount principle in relation to Wildlife and Migratory Birds.
- 3 For the purposes of Agreement-in-Principle negotiations on the topics of Wildlife and Migratory Birds, the Parties agree to negotiate:
  - 3.1 definitions in relation to wildlife such as: Conservation, Endangered Species, Shared Species, Threatened Species, Vulnerable Species, Wildlife, Wildlife Habitat, Migratory Birds and other definitions as appropriate;
  - 3.2 the extent of Ktunaxa law-making authority in relation to Wildlife and Migratory Birds in a defined geographic area;
  - 3.3 the relationship of federal, provincial and Ktunaxa laws;
  - 3.4 means to minimize conflicts of laws in relation to Wildlife and Migratory Birds and to establish priority of laws in the event of conflicts of laws;
  - 3.5 the roles of the Parties in relation to the management of Wildlife, Wildlife Habitat, Migratory Birds and Migratory Birds Habitat;
  - 3.6 a co-operative area-wide approach to Wildlife and Migratory Birds management and the geographic boundaries of areas for that management; and
  - 3.7 provisions relating to non-domestic use of Wildlife by the Ktunaxa.
