of the gift of our language as passed down to us by our
ancestors.*

*The Ktunaxa language is distinctive in the world and is spoken
only by the Ktunaxa people. This language gives evidence of our
existence as a sovereign nation as is the vehicle through which our
history is recorded.*

*Be it known to all, that we, the elected leaders of the
Ktunaxa Nation, Confederated Salish Kootenai Tribes, and the
Kootenai Tribe of Idaho, do hereby proclaim our commitment
to the preservation and protection of the
Ktunaxa language through this declaration.*
