Nomination Guidelines

How to Nominate

Please speak to the youth nominee about this opportunity, and help them to submit the following:

- (a) Filled out application form (at the end of this document)
- (b) Resume **OR** short biography of the nominee
- (c) Personal statement: the nominee must write a brief essay explaining what *Building Certainty, Maximizing Community Resources* means to them and their community. The essay should be no more than one page in length and saved as a .pdf, .doc or .docx.

Eligibility

To enter, nominees must be:

- Between 19-30 years of age
- Aboriginal descent (Inuit, Métis, First Nation)
- Able to travel independently to and from the conference in Toronto from November 16-18.

Preference will be given to nominees:

- Who are members of communities where Teck is active (including operations, projects or exploration activities)
- Demonstrate they have an interest in the mining industry through one of the following:
 - Currently or previously working in the mining industry, or in a position related to the mining industry
 - Pursuing education in a related field
 - A personal or family connection to the mining industry

Deadline

The deadline for nominations is September 15, 2014.

Applications will be accepted before 5 p.m. PST on September 15. Nominees can expect to be notified during the first week of October.
