#### The Nation is Seeking Proposals

From Aboriginal Elders, Leaders, Knowledge Keepers and skilled individuals with the following qualifications:

- Demonstrated ability to deal with cultural issues sensitively and to handle highly confidential personal information
- Knowledge of Aboriginal traditional healing and wellness methods and practices
- ⇒ Practical knowledge of Aboriginal values, traditions, culture and practices
- ⇒ Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- ⇒ Perspectives on Aboriginal culture and traditions:
- ⇒ Valid Driver's Licence and access to a reliable truck;
- ⇒ Positive attitude and capacity to act as a healthy lifestyle model;
- ⇒ Clean criminal record check.
