Ktunaxa Citizens are invited to put their names forward for consideration as a member of the Ktunaxa Nation Interim Citizenship Code Enrollment Board. This five to seven member board will review and make decisions on applications for the granting of Ktunaxa Citizenship and Other Ktunaxa Citizenship in accordance with the criteria set out in the Ktunaxa Nation Interim Citizenship Code. The Board, with the assistance of the Registrar, will also establish policies, procedures and processes to ensure:

- (a) compliance with the Code;
- (b) applicants are fully aware of the criteria and processes;
- (c) applications are reviewed and processed in a fair, equitable and timely manner; and
- (d) procedural fairness is followed in implementing the Code.

Enrollment Board members must be of Ktunaxa ancestry. The selection process will take into consideration knowledge, experience and expertise relevant to the subject area and purpose of the Enrollment Board. The selection process will make every effort to ensure that the Enrollment Board is inclusive of each of the following: individuals who are affiliated with each of the Ktunaxa Communities as well as individuals who are non-status, live off-reserve and youth.

Appointments to this Board are for five year terms with no limit to the number of times a person can be re-appointed. A stipend and if applicable local travel, will be provided to board members for their service on the board.
