Five Ktunaxa Athletes Headed to North American Indigenous Games

Cranbrook/?a·kiskaq≠*i?it* – A contingent of five Ktunaxa athletes are on their way to compete in the 2017 North American Indigenous Games being held in Toronto from July 16th to the 23rd.

The Ktunaxa athletes are Carter Basil-Pelly and Trent Walkley (swimming), Justin Grosso (volleyball), Hana Braker (softball) and Caytlyn Luke (golf).

"The entire Ktunaxa Nation is very proud of our young athletes as they begin their journey to the North America Indigenous Games in Toronto," said Kathryn Teneese, Ktunaxa Nation Council Chair. "The competition will be tough, but I know how hard these five young people have trained and practiced. Carter, Trent, Justin, Hana and Caytlyn are outstanding role models not just to other Ktunaxa youth, but all Ktunaxa people. I am looking forward to hearing about their experiences at the games once they are home."

The North American Indigenous Games are a multi-sport, multi-disciplinary event involving Indigenous youth from Canada and the United States. The games also feature a vibrant cultural program showcasing local and North American indigenous cultural groups.
