Statistics Canada is pleased to offer a free information session on the data that are available for First Nations, Métis, and Inuit from the 2012 Aboriginal People's Survey and the 2011 National Household Survey.

There are a number of analytical and data products on Aboriginal peoples that might be of interest to you, your community or your organization.

On November 25, 2013, new data were released from the 2012 Aboriginal Peoples Survey, describing the education and employment characteristics of First Nations people living off reserve, Métis, and Inuit aged 6 years and older. The survey also collected information on health, language, income, housing and mobility.

Data from the 2011 National Household Survey, released throughout 2013, will also be highlighted with a focus on Aboriginal peoples.
