POSITION SUMMARY

The Registered Care Aide (the "RCA") is responsible for administrating the home and community care program. Daily tasks include assisting clients in the Community with tasks and routines, supporting them to achieve and maintain their best health in consultation with the RN and Collaborative Care Team

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide elder/community care daily; assist clients with personal care and daily activities including cooking, prompting to take medication, assisting with daily exercise, cleaning, attending events/daytrips with them, shopping, and wellness checks and appointments.
- Perform administrative duties related to clients, including maintaining client chart, filing etc.
- Plan social and recreational events and day trips for clients including coordinating event details (venue, food, etc.) and promoting the event to the Community in accordance with annual plans.
- Participating in a collaborative team-based model of care ensuring that client support is in alignment with health and wellness care plans.

The Successful Candidate holds a minimum of 2 years experience in a similar role a Registered Care Aide Certificate, Food Safe Certificate and completion and possession of Valid CPR and First Aid Certificate. A clean criminal record and provide proof of such as well as provision of a clean drivers abstract and a Valid Class 5 driver's license.
