

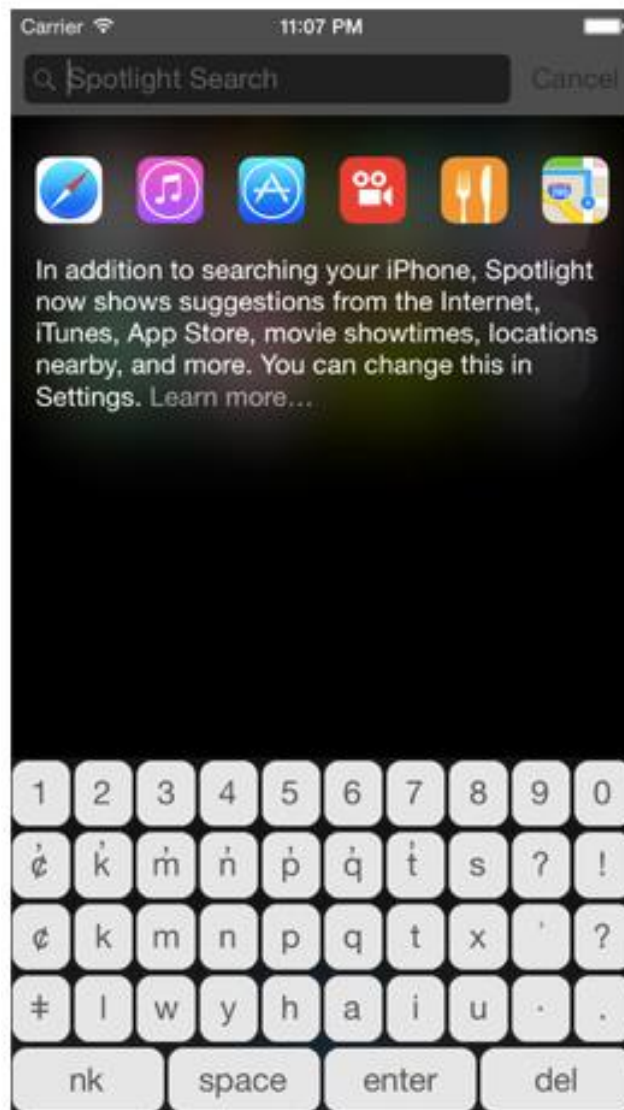
The Ktunaxa Nation is one of the Indigenous speech communities leading the way in developing new resources for language learning in today's world. This includes Apps that add functionality, cultural content and language materials to your smartphones and tablets. The following Apps are now available on the Apple App Store and the Google Play Store. The Apple require iOS 8 or later and the Android App requires 4.1.2 or later.

App Name: KtunaxaFont

A Ktunaxa keyboard for iPhones, iPads and iPods

The KtunaxaFont app adds the Ktunaxa phonetic keyboard to your iOS device's keyboard choices. The app describes installation instructions and keyboard use. When the app is installed a secondary keyboard allows users to enter the characters to write in the Ktunaxa language. These include the following non-English characters: full and small glottal stops, hard consonants (ç, k, m, n, p, q and t), the raised dot for long vowels (a, i and u). When the KtunaxaFont keyboard is enabled with full access it can be used to enter Ktunaxa language into any iOS app, including social media, note taking apps and web browsers. The KtunaxaFont app was sponsored by the Ktunaxa Nation Council and is available free of charge.

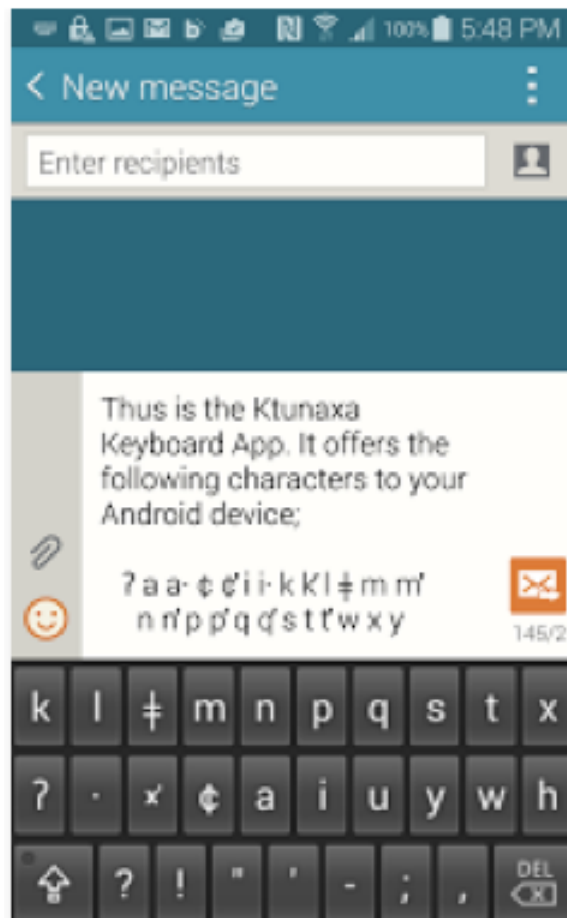


Ktunaxa Keyboard App

A Ktunaxa keyboard for Android devices with OS 4.1.2 and later.

The Ktunaxa Keyboard App is an extension of the Android softkeyboard, which uses 3 keyboard views. The “QWERTY” keyboard appears as the standard Android version. However, the “SYMBOL” keyboard offers the characters required to type the Ktunaxa language, including the vowels (a, i, and u), the raised dot (·) used for long vowels, the consonants (k, l, voiceless l, m, n, p, q, s, t, x, w, and h), the x' (which adds a glottal marker above any consonant), and the gull glottal stop. The “SYMBOL+SHIFT” keyboard offers numbers (0-9) and standard punctuation and commonly used symbols (+, -, =, <, >, etc.). The Ktunaxa Keyboard App is based on the Android soft keyboard API 16. It should run on most Android devices with operating systems between 4.1.2 and 5.0 (including Jelly Bean, KitKat and Lollipop). The Ktunaxa Keyboard App was sponsored by the Ktunaxa Nation Council and is free of charge and open source.



App Name: Ktunaxa Story "Kyukyit"

This is the Ktunaxa storybook "Kyukyit". The story focuses on Ktunaxa greeting at various times of day, and on animal names. The reader can choose to read it her- or himself, or have the book narrated. This App is made available by the Ktunaxa Nation Council Traditional Knowledge and Language Sector.

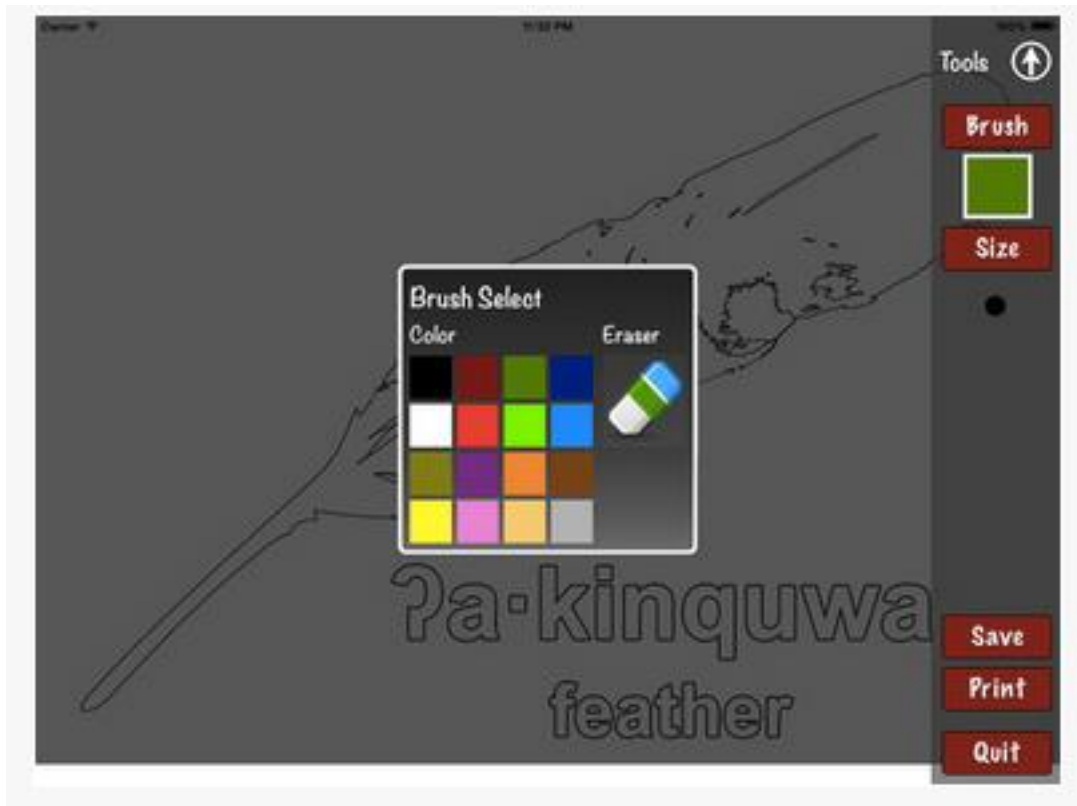


Ktunaxa "Coloring Book"

This is a Coloring Book App. It offers 26 images showcasing Ktunaxa cultural themes. It also presents the Ktunaxa names of the images shown. There are options to change the brush size and colors. When you are done coloring you can save your image to the camera roll or print the image on local network printers. This App is presented free of charge by the Ktunaxa Nation Council Traditional Knowledge and Language Program.
