

Ktunaxa Nation Interim Citizenship Code Referendum

Information for Lower Kootenay Band Members

We were not able to access information that would allow us to verify the identity of Lower Kootenay Band members for the purposes of online or phone-in voting options in relation to the Interim Citizenship Code referendum.

Lower Kootenay Band members who wish to vote on the Ktunaxa Nation Citizenship Code through online or phone-in voting will be required to pre-register with our Electoral Officer, One Feather. The process for pre-registration is as follows:

Call/text our Electoral Officer @ 250-882-1557 or email nicole@onefeather.ca and provide your full name, band registration number (it should start with a 606) and your date of birth. It is also recommended that you provide your email address and phone number for further verification of identity when voting.

If you plan to vote in person at one of the five voting locations on May 8, 2019 you do not need to pre-register, just bring your status card.

Voting stations will be located at each of the following locations from 9am to 7pm (local time) on May 8, 2019:
